


Kelham Island

A striking Victorian building situated on a man-made island over 900 years old, Kelham Island Museum is an iconic venue at the heart of the steel city.



Greet your guests as newlyweds along the enchanting Little Mesters Street and then surprise them with the show-stopping 12,000 horse power River Don Engine in steam.



The white walls of the Arundel Room provide a blank canvas for the happy couple to create the wedding of their dreams.


